**MELTA AND OXFORD FAJAR COLLABORATE TO HOST A
WEBINAR SERIES ON EDUCATION**

The Malaysian English Language Teaching Association (MELTA) is collaborating with Oxford-Fajar to run a series of webinars under the broad theme of “Embracing the path for borderless education”.

The webinar series was conceived in recognition of the fact that the COVID-19 pandemic has affected the global education landscape. Both organisations are committed in ensuring that teachers and the public at large stay connected with issues related to education.

The first webinar was held on 8 May 2020 and drew approximately 300 participants. The session was a vibrant discussion on assessment and how English teachers needed to take a different approach in assessing learner proficiency under Malaysia’s new CEFR-aligned curriculum.

The webinar series will see future presentations on a diverse range of topics which will be of interest to teachers, academics, teacher educators, student teachers and parents.
